

APPENDIX E

LIST OF STREETS WITH A ROAD SURFACE RATING (RSR) OF 50 OR LESS

This contains pertinent information with regards to the condition of streets and sidewalks within the city. The database fields include the following:

GIS ID:	A unique identifier for a segment of pavement being reviewed.
Street:	The name of the street being evaluated
Segment:	The portion of a street being evaluated. Single segment streets are labeled as the street name, whereas streets with more than a single segment are labeled as Street-01, etc.
From:	The starting point of a segment, typically an intersecting street.
To:	The ending point of a segment, typically an intersecting street or a dead end
Inspector:	Initials of person conducting inspection
Inspection Date:	Date of field inspection
Alignment:	Condition of street alignment (Acceptable, Excellent, Failed, Fair, Poor)
Ride:	Ride quality (Acceptable, Excellent, Failed, Fair, Poor)
Pavement Material:	Type of pavement, normally BC (Bituminous Concrete - Hot Mix Asphalt)
Width:	Width of paved surface in feet
Distresses:	Listing of distress types, severity and extent
Length:	The overall length of a segment in feet and miles, taken from the state inventory, existing plans or field observation
RSR:	Roadway Surface Rating - the overall condition of the street surface I
Curb:	Type of curb
Reveal:	Average height of curb above pavement surface
Sidewalk:	Sidewalk exists or does not exist
Striping:	Pavement striping exists or does not exist
