

Metal Exteriors:

Attempt wiping graffiti with:

- Mineral spirits
- Paint thinner
- Acetone
- Goof Off
- WD-40

If first attempt does not work, attempt to remove graffiti by:

- Rubbing with steel or bronze wool, or light sandpaper.
- Power-washing it

If graffiti still exists paint over it.

Wood Exteriors:

For non-weathered wood sealed with paint, stain or sealer:

- Attempt to remove by wiping with mineral spirits.

For weathered wood, do not use mineral spirits since the wood will absorb it, causing the paint to go further into the wood.

- Attempt to Power wash.

If graffiti still remains either sand the wood and re-paint or paint over it.

Plastic Exteriors:

- Wipe graffiti with WD-40. Don't use paint thinners they will damage the surface.
- Lightly rub surface with ultra-fine steel or bronze wool this will remove the paint.

If graffiti still remains paint over it.

Masonry Exteriors:

- Attempt to Power wash.
- Attempt to Sand-blasting.

If graffiti still exists paint over it.

Glass Surfaces:

- Scrape off with a razor blade.
- Wipe with paint thinner.

If the paint does not come completely off after using the razor blade, use ultra-fine bronze wool with water to gently rub the remaining paint off.
