Press Invited to Tour Completed Housing Project for Veterans

(Fall River, MA- September 16th, 2020)- A formerly vacant piece of property at 32 Bradford Avenue has been rehabilitated and turned into housing for Fall River's veterans and their families. This rehabilitation effort was led by the Coogan administration, most notably the Community Development Agency, and the Community Housing Resource Board. Alves Home Improvement executed the project.

The renovation of 32 Bradford Ave has culminated in three new 3-bedroom units, which will be used as income restricted housing for three veterans and their families. Interested veterans must complete an application, obtained from the Fall River Community Housing Resource Board on Bedford St or the Community Development Agency in Government Center. From the pool of applicants, three families will be chosen through a lottery.

To mark the successful rehabilitation of the building and celebrate the opportunity that the home represents for Fall River's veteran community, Mayor Paul Coogan invites members of the press to attend a press conference at the site at 11am on Tuesday September 22nd, followed by a brief tour of the building.
