CONTRACT NO. 2: SOLIDS PROCESSING UPGRADES
IFB-21-16 (ACOUSTICAL TILE)
REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQs)**

In accordance with ST. 2004. c. 193 and M.G.L. c. 149 § 44 (A-M), the City of Fall River, Department of Community Utilities, Sewer Commission is seeking qualified acoustical tile filed sub-contractors to submit Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) for the construction of improvements to the existing wastewater treatment facility (WWTF).

General contractors and filed sub-contractors must be pre-qualified to bid on the project. Statements of Qualifications were received for this Project on March 11, 2021 for general contractors and filed subcontractors. Filed sub-bid categories include: masonry; miscellaneous and ornamental iron; waterproofing, dampproofing and caulking; roofing and flashing; metal windows; glass and glazing; tile; acoustical tile; resilient floors; painting; elevators; plumbing; heating, ventilation and air conditioning; and electrical work.

*** The City of Fall River is requesting Statements of Qualifications from acoustical tile filed sub-contractors who did not submit on or before March 11, 2021. In accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 44D, Statements of Qualifications received on or before March 11, 2021 from general contractors and filed subcontractors shall remain valid. Resubmittal is not required for prequalification. ***

The Fall River WWTF is an oxygen activated sludge secondary treatment plant with an average monthly permitted capacity of 30.9 mgd and treats flows from a combined sewer system. The WWTF wet weather capacity is 106 mgd for primary treatment/disinfection and 50 mgd for secondary treatment processes. The project consists of process upgrades to the thickening, dewatering, sludge storage and odor control systems of the solids processing facilities. A new building will be constructed as an expansion of the existing Solids Handling Building where prior demolition of an existing structure has been completed. The new building will include personnel locker rooms, offices, laboratory, and administrative spaces. The existing Administration Building will be renovated, to include offices, restrooms, lunchroom, and training/conference room. All buildings include but are not limited to architectural, structural, HVAC, plumbing, electrical and instrumentation and controls upgrades or new work. The work under this Contract will also include any other work necessary to complete the work including demolition, hazardous materials abatement and/or disposal, site work, yard piping and electrical/instrumentation distribution.
