GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Under the direct supervision of the Commanding Officer (Staff Services) or other designee assigned by the Police Chief to perform work involved in a variety of maintenance and skilled repair and other duties on motor equipment of all types, including the overhauling, repairing and maintenance of engines and component assemblies, used in automotive, construction and other motor-driven equipment; performs related tasks.

Essential Functions

Work involves the performance of skilled repairs and maintenance servicing duties, including those of preventive maintenance on motor equipment of all types, including cars, trucks, mowers and other types of motor equipment and providing timely and efficient service to department equipment for a variety of automotive service functions; to be responsible for conformance to City standards of all work performed; this work is performed in conformance with policies and directives of the Police Chief as delegated to the Commanding Officer (Staff Services) or other designee assigned by the Police Chief and is subject to periodic review; and to perform miscellaneous automotive service functions for the Police Department.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with peers and supervisors; ability to work cooperatively and harmoniously with other city employees; a positive "can-do" attitude; ability to observe and follow necessary safety precautions; willingness to work overtime as required; ability to perform basic mathematical calculations as required by duties described above; ability to perform duties with some latitude for independent judgment; ability to use tools in connection with duties described above; ability to follow oral directions; ability to maintain records in connection with duties described above, including inventory records; ability to read and interpret various maintenance manuals.

Acceptance Experience and Training:

A motor vehicle driver's license valid in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is required. In addition, candidates must have a minimum of three (3) years full-time paid experience acquired within the last ten (10) years as an auto mechanic; or graduation from an accredited trade or vocational high school or equivalent training program to make up to two (2) years equivalent experience of the three (3) years required. Experience in Collision repair is a plus. Current ASE/ICAR certification as an Automobile Technician with competence in the following fields: Suspension in steering, brakes, electrical/electronic systems, heating and air-conditioning, engine performance.
