General Statement of Duties:

Work involves providing timely and efficient service to the people of the City for responsibility of performing skilled electrical work and to perform other related tasks as assigned by the Police Chief; to be responsible for conformance to federal, state and city codes and standards of all work performed; this work is performed with some latitude of action and is performed in conformance with policies and directives of the Police Chief and is subject to periodic review by the immediate supervisor to coordinate the work for which she/he is responsible with the work of coworkers; and to perform miscellaneous electrical functions for the Police Department; may perform other tasks as required.

- Performs skilled electrical work at the journeyman level;
- Is responsible for complete maintenance and upkeep of Police Department Communications systems, making sure that FCC specifications are maintained and that proper procedures are followed;
- Is responsible for maintenance, installation and repair of all Traffic signals in the city;
- Assists State Engineers in drawing plans and specifications for traffic signal installations;
- Maintains alarm system and video system for Police Department;
- Installs, tests, repairs and maintains vehicle emergency lights and sirens;
- Troubleshoots and repairs faulty electrical wiring, defective electrical equipment and switches, sockets, etc.
- Uses common hand tools and electrical ohm test equipment such as meters, voltmeters; ammeters, growler, mutineers, and other test equipment;
- May supervise helpers and apprentices;
- Performs related work as assigned;
- Performs other general maintenance work around Police station;
- Performs related work as required including operation of motor vehicle for transportation purposes of self and equipment;

Minimum Qualifications:

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with peers and supervisors; ability to work cooperatively and harmoniously with other city employees; a positive "can-do" attitude; ability to observe necessary safety precautions; willingness to work overtime hours as required; a motor vehicle permit; ability to perform basic reading and writing functions as required by tasks described above; ability to perform described duties with some latitude for independent judgment under supervision. This position requires extraordinary physical effort.

Education and Experience:

Five years (5) of electrical experience, a journeyman electrician's license from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is required. Once hired, must attend IMSA classes and Maintain work zone safety and Traffic signal technician certificates. Must obtain 1B and 2B Hoisting license within 180 days of employment. EEO
