

MEDIA ADVISORY: Fall River.

Light Structure Removal along Route 195 EB Ramp to Rte. 24 NB

February 8th, 2023

Night-time Operation 10:00 pm – 10:30 pm

Fall River-The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing that it will be performing a light structure removal along Route 195 EB as follows:

- Rte. 195 EB Exit 14B to Rte. 24 NB Closure

Work will be Wednesday night February 8th from 10:00 pm to 10:30 pm

Temporary Traffic Control Typical Details and Massachusetts Guidelines for MassDOT will be utilized, using police detail officers.

Road closures on the ramp will be in place as needed while work is ongoing. Emergency vehicles will be allowed passage at all times.

The detours to be implemented are as follow:

Detour: Work at Rte. 195 EB EXIT 14B (Rte. 24 North)

Traveling Route I-195 East

- Exit 14B (Route. 24 NB) Closed.
- Go straight on Route I-195 East.
- Take Exit 16 to Route 88 South to Rt 6 Toward Horseneck Beach.
- Turn right onto Route 6 East Toward Dartmouth.
- Turn Left to merge onto Route 88 North to I-195 West toward New Bedford /Providence RI.
- Take Exit 14B to Route 24 North.

Drivers who are traveling through the affected areas should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and/or may be impacted due to an emergency situation.

- Dial 511 before heading out onto the roadways and select a route to hear real-time conditions.
- Visit www.mass511.com, a website which provides real-time traffic and incident advisory information, access to traffic cameras, and allows users to subscribe to text and email alerts for traffic conditions.
